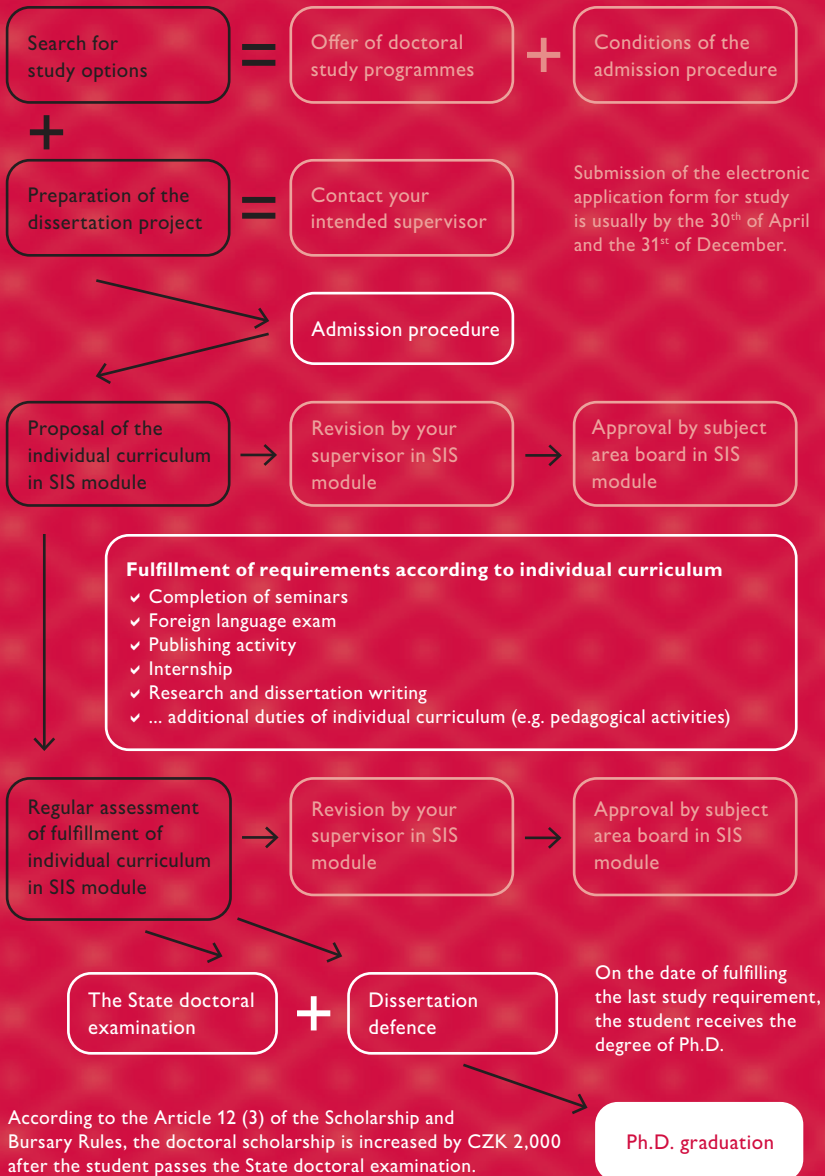

The Process of Ph.D. Studies at Charles University





Are you interested in a scientific career? What should you know about studying in the doctoral study programme?

Length of studies

The standard length of doctoral study programmes is three or four years (maximum is eight years).

Study forms

Doctoral study programmes are taught in two forms; full-time or part-time.

Study in the cotutelle form

Doctoral studies with dual supervision of dissertations (known under the French name *cotutelle*) take place on the basis of cooperation between Charles University and a university abroad. Joint supervision of a dissertation is shared by two supervisors. One from each involved institution – and the student spends a part of the doctoral programme at both institutions.

Scholarship & grants

In **full-time** studies, students receive a **monthly doctoral scholarship** (<https://cuni.cz/UKEN-372.html>), which is usually supplemented by other sources of income, e.g. for participation in grant projects or for teaching undergraduates. The amount of the scholarship depends on the faculty. As a Ph.D. student, **you can apply for grants and request financial support** (GAUK <https://cuni.cz/UKEN-753.html>, START Programme <https://cuni.cz/UKEN-1340.html>).

Process of doctoral study at Charles University

The first duty of every doctoral student is to **prepare an individual curriculum** together with a supervisor, which clearly defines the **study duties throughout the standard length of the study programme** (completion of seminars, foreign language exam, conferences, internship, research, pedagogical duties, etc.).

The evaluation of fulfillment of the individual curriculum is monitored annually by the **Subject area board** – a group of renowned experts who ensure your research will be top quality.

The supervisor and the consultant have an irreplaceable role in the doctoral study process. Supervisor is the main partner and an academic who is responsible for **guiding a doctoral student through the whole process** by recommending specialized literature, teaching how to present research study as well as showing how to raise funds for projects. Consultant is a leading specialist in the relevant field of research who is able to advise doctoral students with a specific topic of dissertation. The role of the consultant is optional.

The title “doctor” is awarded upon **the successful completion of the State doctoral examination and the defence of the dissertation.**
