As part of the European Investment Fund's (EIF) Legal team, and at a level commensurate with her/his seniority, the (Senior) Lawyer(s) will mainly advise on private equity and venture capital funds investments, including co-investments.

Reporting Line:

The incumbent(s) will work autonomously under the supervision of the Head of Division.

Responsibilities:

- Contribute to the structuring and development of transactions;
- Negotiate the legal aspects of transactions, as well as follow-up and monitoring in relation to the EIF's transactions portfolio;
- Liaise where necessary with external consultants and supervise their work;
- Maintain a specialist competence in equity, as well as other areas in which the EIF operates;
- Actively contribute to knowledge sharing within the team;
- Contribute to the design and development of new financial instruments;
- Be involved, as necessary, in other matters relating to EIF's activities.

Qualifications:

- University degree in law, preferably complemented with a post-graduate degree;
- At least two (2) years (Lawyer) and at least five (5) years' (Senior Lawyer) post-qualification professional experience preferably in a leading international law firm;
- Thorough knowledge and proven track record of private equity/venture capital investment transactions;
- Experience in Fund of Funds would be a plus;
- Excellent command of written and spoken English. Knowledge of other EU languages, especially German, would be a significant advantage.
